The Bishop Flores Scholars will provide 1 million dollars in tuition assistance in 2017-2018. The tuition assistance will be awarded first-come first-served on the basis of financial need for students entering Kindergarten through high school. The awards are based on household size and income, with grants up to a third of the total cost of tuition with a maximum of four recipients per family.

***PENNY WARS**

1. Each class will have one container.

Some of the Changes to include: (approved by the Finance Council)

- 10 and 12 month payment option
- Registration (\$200 per child) Must Be Paid In Full by July 1 or a \$75 late fee will be assessed
- Increased sibling discounts from 10%/25%/50% to 15%/50%/75%
- Tech Fee, Sacrament Fee, Camp Fee and Grad Fee increased \$25
- Different tuition rates/increases for registered contributing St. Peter parishioners vs Catholic but not registered or contributing vs Non Catholic
- Tuition assistance applications are available after completing registration paperwork
