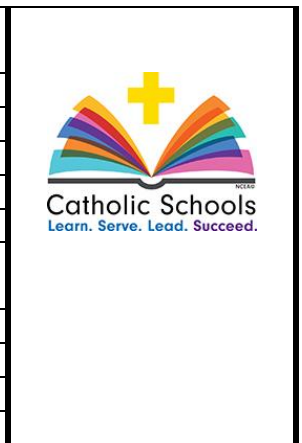

It's Official!

We just received official permission from the Diocese to promote our Transitional Kindergarten program. We have always made individual accommodations for Kindergarten students needing the "gift of time" but now we are officially a TK school!

Transitional Kindergarten

Transitional Kindergarten (TK) is designed to support students who may not be academically, socially, or emotionally ready for Kindergarten, but repeating a year in PreK may not be in the child's best interest. The focus of Transitional Kindergarten is on academic preparedness for mastery of the Kindergarten curriculum and expectations. Typically, students recommended for TK are those with birthdays between September and December. Transitional Kindergarten provides the "gift of time" with a second year in Kindergarten for those students needing additional time for social, emotional, language development or communication skills.
