### Financial Report

Fr. Ramon has approved the recommendation of the Finance Council, to publish the July-December finance report. As you can see, we were/are prepared to see quite a large deficit by the end of the year. However, we have been cutting expenses and making plans to cover the amount. If things continue in this direction and with the help of the Diocese, the Parish, YOU—the fundraisers, we will be able to open our doors next year. Praise God! Some more cuts may have to happen, but the real answer to the current financial problem is **we need more students!** There is now a \$100 referral bonus in place for you for every student who enrolls with you as the referral!
