### 529 plans

A **529 plan** is a tax-advantaged savings **plan** designed to encourage saving for future college costs. **529 plans**, legally known as “qualified tuition **plans**,” are sponsored by states, state agencies, or educational institutions and are authorized by Section **529** of the Internal Revenue Code. 529 plans can now be used for K-12 expenses.

- Plans can distribute up to \$10,000 each year for tuition incurred for enrollment or attendance at a public, private, or religious elementary or secondary school.
- The \$10,000 limit for elementary and secondary school is applied on a per-student limit.”

**Lenten Reminders: Days of Abstinence:** No meat can be eaten on Ash Wednesday and all of the Fridays during Lent. This applies to all Catholics 14 and older.

**Days of Fast:** Only one full meal is permitted on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday for Catholics between 18 and 59. Two smaller meals are permitted, but the small meals should not equal a second full meal. Drinking coffee, tea and water between meals is allowed. Snacks between meals are not allowed.

Even though the students are not required to follow the Days of Abstinence and Fast, due to their age, we do teach and practice Days of Fasting and Abstinence.
